Activity 2: Suggested Format




Job Description	 Overview of role Typical responsibilities/tasks ("day in the life" of)
Desired Skills + Experience	 What are the required ("must have") skills? What are other desirable ("nice to have") skills that may appear on an employer's "wish list"?
Optional	 What is the selection process: do they actively recruit or is this based on networking / referrals / "leads"? What does the interview process entail? What styles of interviews are used (behavioural, technical, panel?) What are the employment options like in Vancouver?








CSI Career Map






